

# Congregation Bamidbar Privacy Policy

In this document, the terms “we”, “us” and “our” and the names “Congregation Bamidbar” and “Bamidbar” are understood to refer to Congregation Bamidbar Shel Ma’alah.

Protecting your private information is our priority.

This Privacy Policy governs the usage and collection of:

- Data collected on <https://BamidbarCONNECT.com>
- Data collected on our e-commerce site – the web address is To Be Determined
- Payment data collected using mobile payment technology
- Subscriptions to our E-Tree, whereby you can be notified via email of Bamidbar news and events
- Data collected from membership applications, religious school applications and related documents provided to Bamidbar

By using the Bamidbar website, or filling out the documents described above, you consent to the data practices described in this Policy.

## Information We Collect

### Membership Information

If you fill out a membership application, or a religious school application, we will ask for personal information including

- Name
- Mailing address
- E-mail Address
- Phone Number
- Religious background, to determine your eligibility to become a member
- Information about your children, including names, ages, whether you are going to enroll them in our religious school and when they will become B’nai Mitzvah

### Payment Information

If you use our e-commerce side to pay dues, make donations or purchase goods, we will ask for personal information including

- Name
- Mailing and shipping addresses
- E-mail Address
- Phone Number
- Payment information including credit or debit card numbers

## E-Tree Subscriptions

If you subscribe to our e-tree, we will ask for personal information including

- Name
- E-Mail Address

## Non-Personally-Identifiable Information

Information about your computer hardware and software may be automatically collected by Bamidbar. This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring website addresses. This information is used for the operation of our online services, to maintain quality of service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of Bamidbar websites. It can't be used to identify you.

## Cookies

Bamidbar websites may use "cookies" to help you personalize your online experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a web server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you.

One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to share information with a web server when you return to a website. Bamidbar websites may use cookies to enable our web server to automatically recall your specific information on subsequent visits. That information can then be retrieved, so you won't have to provide it again.

You have the ability to accept or decline cookies. Most Web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. If you choose to decline cookies, you may not be able to fully experience the interactive features of the Bamidbar services or websites you visit.

## How We Use Your Personal Information

Bamidbar collects and uses your personal information to operate the e-commerce portion of its website.

Bamidbar does not sell, rent or lease its member lists to third parties.

Bamidbar will disclose your personal information, without notice, only if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process, or orders from law enforcement; (b) protect and defend the rights or property of Bamidbar; and, (c) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of Bamidbar, or the public.

## Opt-Out/Unsubscribe

We respect your privacy and give you an opportunity to opt-out of receiving email announcements from the E-Tree. Users may opt-out of receiving all bulk email communications from Bamidbar by clicking the Unsubscribe link at the bottom of any such email, or by sending an unsubscribe request to **[bamidbar@BamidbarCONNECT.com](mailto:bamidbar@BamidbarCONNECT.com)**.

## Security of your Personal Information

Bamidbar uses Transport Layer Security (TLS) to secure communications between your computer or mobile device and our web server. Look for the green lock icon in your web browser. Any web address on any Bamidbar site will start with **https://** (the “s” stands for “Secure”).

Credit and debit card numbers processed online, or using mobile payment technology, NEVER touch Bamidbar’s web server. Instead, they are sent directly from your device to our payment processor, in a secure manner, in compliance with PCI-DSS, a group of banking industry regulations and standards governing transmission and storage of credit/debit card information.

Bamidbar complies with all applicable federal, state and local laws regarding credit card and debit card payments.

## Children Under Thirteen

To remain in compliance with federal laws protecting the privacy of minor children younger than thirteen years old, Bamidbar does not knowingly collect personally identifiable information online, from children under the age of thirteen. If you are under the age of thirteen, you must ask your parent or guardian for permission to use any Bamidbar website.

Bamidbar DOES collect information about your minor children when you complete a membership application, as described elsewhere in this document, and such data collection is used as described in the section titled “How We Use Your Personal Information.”

## Privacy Regulations Outside the United States

Bamidbar is a US entity. We have not taken steps to conform to the UK’s General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), or the privacy laws in any country outside the US.

## Third-Party Websites Linked from Bamidbar Websites

Bamidbar encourages you to review the privacy policies of websites you choose to link to from Bamidbar websites, so that you can understand how those websites collect, use and share your information. Bamidbar is not responsible for the privacy policies or other content on websites we don’t control.

## Changes to this Policy

Bamidbar will occasionally update this Privacy Policy to reflect organization and member feedback. Bamidbar encourages you to periodically review this Policy to stay informed about how we are protecting your information.
